

Cyber Essentials Plus Remediation and Reporting

Remediation

The Assessor is expected to provide the client with all relevant information regarding any failing points or vulnerabilities that require remediation. The Assessor is also expected to provide the client with sufficient detail about the vulnerability and guidance for remediation to aid in timely remediation by the organisation. This is to be passed to the client and forms part of the formal report, detailed below.

Reporting

The formal report will need to be carried out by the Assessor entering the outcomes onto the assessment platform using the report template associated with CE Plus account for the applicant.

All Cyber Essentials Plus audit reports should be signed off by a Lead Assessor, who is overall responsible for the standard of the audit carried out by the Assessor. The Assessor and the Lead Assessor can be the same named person.
